RESOLUTION NO. 437-2024

“A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HON. JOSHUA CARLO R. MENDOZA, OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF PAYAO, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) FIELD OFFICE IX, GEN. VICENTE ALVAREZ STREET, ZAMBOANGA CITY, FOR THE 14TH CYCLE SUPPLEMENTARY FEEDING PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION.”

WHEREAS; presented for the consideration of this August Body is a letter from the Municipal Mayor requesting the Sangguniang Bayan to pass a Resolution authorizing him to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) regarding the 14th Cycle Supplementary Feeding Program Implementation in the Municipality;

WHEREAS; RA 11037 mandates the institutionalization of a comprehensive National Feeding Program for the undernourished children in Public Day Care, Kidergarten and Elementary Schools noting the confirmed link between food and nutrition and the capacity of children to develop and learn;

WHEREAS; the DSWD mandate to provide social welfare and develop programs, has been providing community-based nutrition programs and services such as Food for School and Healthy, Start Feeding Programs in child development centers at the local government units to promote community participation;

WHEREAS; the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates local government units to provide health and social welfare services to its constituents which includes programs and projects for the welfare of the child and youth;

WHEREAS; RA 11037 directed the DSWD , in coordination with the local government units concerned, to implement supplemental feeding program in day Care Center or in any other facility used for such purposes;

WHEREAS; this collaborative effort of the DSWD and the LGU shall be for the best interest of the beneficiary day care children in order to promote the overall health wellness and well-being;

ON MOTION; by **HON. GLADY A. LOPEZ**, and unanimously seconded, it was


